*Feminism & Psychology* is a quarterly peer-reviewed academic journal that covers feminist theory and practice in psychology. It was established in 1991 and is published by SAGE Publications.

## Abstracting and indexing

The journal is abstracted and indexed in Scopus and the Social Sciences Citation Index. According to the *Journal Citation Reports*, the journal has a 2015 impact factor of 3.377, ranking it 53rd out of 129 journals in the category "Psychology, Multidisciplinary" and 11th out of 40 journals in the category "Women's Studies".<sup>[1]</sup> The journal has a 2022 impact factor of 3.377.<sup>[2]</sup>
